Project Overview

- Upgrade of **fire doors and fire stopping** throughout to ensure full compliance with current fire safety regulations.

Challenges & Solutions

The refurbishment began during the summer recess of 2025 and continues into the academic term. With students returning in September, Quest Interiors has implemented strict protocols to manage site cleanliness, restrict movement, and maintain a respectful presence within the halls. This includes clear communication with residents and facilities teams to ensure a positive working relationship.
