Project Overview

Quest Interiors was appointed to **refurbish the top floor** of teaching spaces at Thomas's London Day Schools. The brief focused on creating a calm and thoughtful design to enhance the learning environment for students, all within a restricted summer timeframe and challenging site conditions.

Scope of Works

- Full strip-out and refurbishment of top-floor classrooms and ancillary spaces.
- Delivery of a serene, student-focused design, incorporating natural tones and textures.
- Coordination of mechanical and electrical services within existing constraints.
- Implementation of **bespoke joinery** and finishes to optimise space and functionality.
- Careful planning to overcome access limitations (no lift), ensuring safe and efficient material handling.

Challenges & Solutions

- **Tight programme** during the summer break required accelerated scheduling and meticulous coordination.
- No lift access meant all materials and equipment were manually transported, requiring robust logistics planning.
- Worked closely with the school to ensure **zero disruption** to operations and readiness for the new term.

Outcome

Completed on time and within budget, the refurbished top floor now provides a calm, inspiring environment for students and staff. The project demonstrates Quest Interiors' ability to deliver high-quality design solutions under challenging conditions.
